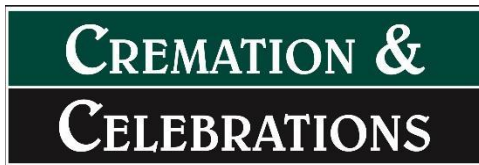

Co-ordinating Rites and Ceremonies

Co-ordination of all rites and ceremonies, before, during, and after they have been provided, including services and supplies provided by us, as well as those provided by third party suppliers, such as flowers and obituaries. Below you will find both our Standard and *Essentials Only* level of services. We are pleased to allow our families to select and pay for only the services they require.

Standard Co-ordinating – We will be pleased to meet at your family's convenience to discuss all our offerings and cater a unique and appropriate farewell. Your family will also have a meeting with our Aftercare specialist to guide you through the first few steps of settling an estate. We are often told that our Aftercare service is invaluable to families feeling overwhelmed by the immense amount of administrative work that follows a death. In our Standard offering we will provide a level of service we believe to be second to none.

Essentials Only Co-ordinating – For those seeking only to meet the legal requirements of our local, provincial, and federal governments we are pleased to help you do just that. This offering of our professional services allows you to pay for the “musts” and simply select any additional services that YOU feel your family may require. These appointments will be scheduled during the set hours of Monday-Friday 9 AM – 5 PM, excluding statutory holidays. We will provide you with necessary CPP forms, and our C.A.R.E. guide.

Subsequent Co-ordinating – Occasionally, families may have the need to deal with two separate funeral providers. This fee would apply if your family has worked with another funeral provider for some or all arrangements for your loved one (ie. death registration, cremation, etc.). In this instance we provide our Standard level of service at a reduced fee due to some duplication.

Documentation - Completion and filing of all documents necessary to meet the legal requirements of our local, provincial, and federal governments, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, Coroner's Certificate for Cremation, and documentation necessary to ship the body out of the country when applicable. We will also inform the government to cancel C.P.P. and Old Age Security payments.

CARE CENTRE

Basic Handling and Preparation of Remains - These services include placement of the deceased into the casket or cremation container. (Also requires Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/Shelter)

Embalming of Remains - Embalming is the process of replacing blood and bodily fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation/service/celebration or disposition of the deceased. Our licensed funeral directors will make a recommendation based on the condition of the body and expected service needs. It can be expected that after 24 hours from the time of death, either cooling or embalming will be required. (charged in addition to Basic Handling and Preparation of Remains)

Pacemaker Removal - This is required if cremation is chosen and there is a pacemaker. Pacemakers contain combustible material and will damage cremation equipment at the family's expense if not removed. This procedure will be completed by a licensed funeral director.

Cooling - As one of the few funeral homes that have their own in-house (Exeter location) refrigerated area, we are proud to offer cooling that may be required, due to no embalming or delayed funeral arrangements (family travel, illness, weather). This fee is charged in addition to the Facilities for Preparation/Embalming/ Sheltering fee.

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and paid for on your behalf by the funeral home. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements.

Coroner’s Cremation Certificate – Charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario.

Cremation Fee – Charged by the crematorium for the actual cremation process to take place.

BAO Consumer Protection Fee - Responsible for protection of the public interest, the BAO regulates, ensures compliance with the law, and supports licensed professionals across the province.

Clergy Honorarium – Amount paid to the clergy for their services. In some cases the amount is set by the clergy, in other cases it is an amount to be determined by you.

Media Announcements – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers, radio, or other media outlets.

Cemetery Interment Fee – Charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of a grave. It varies by cemetery. Most cemeteries have an additional fee for interments scheduled on weekends and holidays.

Municipal Death Registration Fee – Charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may vary.

Soloist/Organist/Musician Honourariums – Case by case basis.

Luncheon Fee – many families choose to have a luncheon catered by a church/service group. These groups often charge a per person fee between \$10 and \$25 per person.

Payment, Financing and Funding

Payment - If Standard Co ordinating is selected payment in full is due 30 days from the date of this contract (the "Due Date"). If Essentials Only Co ordinating is selected payment in full is due 15 days from the date of this contract (the "Due Date"). Amounts outstanding after that date will bear interest at the rate of 2% per month (or 26.82 % per annum calculated daily and compounded monthly), from the Due Date until paid in full. There will be a charge of \$50.00 for any non sufficient funds (NSF) cheques returned by the bank. Any costs of collection shall be the responsibility of the Purchaser. The Provider may charge an additional 2% of the total amount, should the Purchaser opt to pay by credit card.

Prepayment Funding - For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today, and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.

Trust: You may pay the money directly to "Guaranteed Funeral Deposits" and we will arrange to place it in trust, where it will accrue interest until the contract is fulfilled (when the services and supplies are delivered) or the contract is cancelled.

Insurance: You may purchase an insurance contract where the proceeds of the insurance contract will be used to pay for the services or supplies at the time they are delivered or the contract is cancelled. Purchasing an insurance contract can afford the option of paying over time for these expenses. Many payment plans and options exist.
